History: Peggy Abkhazi (1902-1994) was born Marjorie Mabel Jane Carter in Shanghai, China, on December 12, 1902, the daughter of Mabel and William Carter. Her mother returned to England in 1906 with Peggy. Mabel died there that summer and Peggy's father died shortly afterwards in China. Peggy lived for a time with relatives in England before being adopted by a well off couple, Thomas and Florence Pemberton, who had returned to England from Shanghai. She took the surname Pemberton.

Thomas Pemberton died in 1918. In 1920, Peggy and Florence Pemberton went to Shanghai where they lived intermittently until Florence's death in 1938. They returned to Europe in 1922, living in England and Paris then went back to Shanghai in 1923 and 1924, via Australia, New Zealand and Hawaii. Between 1927 and 1938 they traveled between Shanghai and Europe. During that time, about 1930, Peggy was married for a short time in Shanghai, and subsequently divorced. Florence Pemberton died in China in 1938 leaving Peggy financially independent.

After her adoptive mother's death, Peggy took the surname Pemberton-Carter. She continued to live in Shanghai. In 1940, she visited Shanghai friends, the Mackenzie, in Victoria, where they had retired, but returned to Shanghai. She was interned there by the Japanese from 1943 to 1945. This experience forms the basis of her book [A Curious Cage](#), published in 1981. At the end of the war Muriel Mackenzie established contact with her and Peggy came to Victoria and in early 1946 bought property on Fairfield Road.

Nicolas Abkhazi (1899-1987) was born in Georgia, the son of Constantine and Helene Abkhazi. His father was referred to in a London Times report on his death as "a former Marshall of the Georgian nobility". Nicolas and his mother left Georgia following the Russian revolution. He lived in France from ca.1919 to 1946, as a student and in various occupations. He had met Peggy in the 1920s when she and Florence Pemberton lived briefly in Paris. Nicolas and Peggy had maintained a correspondence and he managed to contact her when the war ended. They met in New York in 1946 and were married in Victoria in November 1946. They built their house on the Fairfield Road property in 1947 and began the development of their extensive garden.

Nicolas died in 1987 and Peggy in 1994. Subsequently, the property was acquired by The Land Conservancy and the house and garden are open to the public.

Scope: The fonds consists of manuscripts and letter-diaries of Peggy Abkhazi, personal documents of Peggy Abkhazi, 1943-1946, personal documents of Nicolas Abkhazi, 1917-1941, Abkhazi family memorabilia, photographs documenting the life and travels of Peggy and Florence Pemberton, a few photographs of Nicolas Abkhazi in France and of his parents, photographs documenting in detail the building of the house on Fairfield Road and the development of the garden, 1947-1948, and photographs documenting the Abkhazi's social life in Victoria, holidays, particularly on Long Beach, and the garden in its mature years. Peggy Abkhazi's letter-diaries and manuscripts consist of a handwritten letter-diary, 1943, a typescript, "Manuscript of (Mrs.) Peggy Pemberton-Carter written during internment in Lunghua Prison Camp, Shanghai" with accompanying watercolours by Deidre Fee and Lilian Schlee; a typescript of The Curious Cage; and a typescript "Dragon aunt remembers, 1900-1980" chronicling Peggy's life until 1940.

SERIES DESCRIPTIONS

Series 1. Peggy Pemberton-Carter to 1946 series. ca.1902-1945.--10 files.

The series consists of 2 letter-diaries and an autobiographical account (later published as A Curious Cage) of Peggy Pemberton-Carter's internment in Shanghai during World War 11; water colours by D. Fee and L. Schlee of the internment camp and a water colour portrait of Peggy Pemberton-Carter; a typescript autobiography titled Dragon Aunt Remembers, 1900-1980 (the autobiography ends with her marriage in 1946); her birth certificate; and miscellaneous documents and records re her internment and return to Victoria in 1945.

Series 2. Nicolas Abkhazi to 1945 series.--ca. 1917-1941.-- 12 files.

The series consists of personal documents (birth certificate, passport, certificate of naturalization as a French citizen, etc.) and documents relating to Abkhazi property in Georgia; a post card, an envelope, and a portion of a letter written in Georgian; and Nicolas Abkhazi's prisoner of war number on a piece of wood.
