Peter B. McAllister was the founder of the campaign to protect the Great Bear Rainforest from clear cutting; and founder of the Raincoast Conservation Society which was originally formed to support the campaign.

## Scope and content

---

The collection consists of published articles and photographs with commentary by Peter M. McAllister concerning the Great Bear Rainforest Campaign which began in 1990 to protect what is now called the Great Bear Rainforest, a temperate rainforest of approximately 64,000 km<sup>2</sup> on the North-Central Coast of British Columbia.
