Fonds level description

Title: Derrick and Gwen Mallard fonds

Dates: 1947-2001 ; predominant 1970-1997

Extent: 5.7 m of textual records and other materials

Biographical sketch:

Derrick Mallard was born in 1921 in England. In 1953, he emigrated to B.C. and worked in the Engineering Dept. of the B.C. Power Commission and B.C. Hydro. After leaving B.C. Hydro he taught at S.F.U in the Department of Psychology, lecturing on human acoustics and electronic physiological measurements. Gwen Mallard was born ca. 1917 in Fernie, B.C. In 1969, Derrick and Gwen started S.P.E.C. (Society for Promoting Environmental Conservation) in Vancouver, the first citizens environmental organization in western Canada, with Bernard Hagell, Dr. Robin Harger, John Haywood, Ralph Lundahl, Larry McConnell, John Stigant, Dr. A. Turnbull and others. In 1972, the Mallards severed ties with S.P.E.C., moved to Victoria and started C.A.S.E. (Citizens Association to Save the Environment), which they directed until their deaths. Derrick was involved in many projects relating to a broad spectrum of environmental concerns, including waste management, preservation of significant ecosystems, climate change and energy conservation. Gwen was particularly interested in food and nutrition, biotechnology and bovine growth hormone. From 1982 on, Gwen owned and operated Gwen's Vegetarian Diner. The Mallards were among the first in B.C. to speak on behalf of the environment and to enlist widespread public support. In 1992, they were awarded the Joint Environmental Award from the B.C. Minister of the Environment, Lands and Parks; in 1993, they were awarded the Lifetime Environmental Achievement Award by the Canadian Minister of the Environment. Gwen died in 1999, and Derrick died in 2001.

Scope and content:

Fonds consists of records related to the environmental activism and activities of Gwen and Derrick Mallard. The fonds is arranged in 12 series: Alpha-numeric series (A1-W27), 1959-93; Derrick Mallard series, 1947-2001; Gwen Mallard series, 1968-97; B.C. Environmental Associations, 1972-2000; BC Environmental newsletters, 1970-2000; Community Associations, 1990-2000; Capital Regional District, 1990-2000; Foundations, 1994-2000; Issues, 1973-2000; Land preservation, 1990-2000; Awards, 1992-2001; and Promotional displays and graphic materials, [1972-1996].

Arrangement:

The Alpha-Numeric system was established by Derrick Mallard in the early years of his environmental work. The files, the majority of which were un-filed, constitute the Mallards' research materials relating to their C.A.S.E. work. These have been arranged in series reflecting the subject groupings of his early alpha-numeric system. Administrative files relating to C.A.S.E. have been arranged in the B.C. Environmental Associations series.

Approximately 300 reports and publications have been transferred to Special Collections, and cataloged as the Derrick Mallard Collection. They are on a wide variety of environmental subjects, including: water, sewage, transportation, parks, farming, noise, fishing, endangered species and global issues.

Physical description: Other materials include slides, photographs, VHS videocassettes, and audio cassettes.

Dates: 1959-1993

Extent: 1.8 m of textual records and graphic materials. – 2 audio cassettes.

Scope and content:

Series consists of research materials generated and gathered by Gwen and Derek Mallard in the course of their activities, including environmental activism and work for C.A.S.E. The materials cover a large range of environmental topics and are related to numerous environmental organizations or government departments and initiatives. Primary topics include: air pollution; agriculture; composting systems; food; mining; noise pollution; pesticides and pest control; pollution control; and pulp mills. Organizations include: Association for the Protection of Rural Central Saanich; British Columbia Environmental Network; Citizens Association to Save the Environment (C.A.S.E.); Capital Regional District; BC Government; Commission on Resources and Environment (C.O.R.E.); Forest Inquiry Pollution Control Branch; Greater Victoria Water District; Society Promoting Environmental Conservation (S.P.E.C.); Waste Management Advisory Group (W.M.A.G.); World Health Organization; and others.

Scope and content:

Series consists of records related to the activities of Derrick Mallard, including articles and essays, correspondence, newspaper clippings, and photographs. Topics include teaching at S.F.U. and environmental issues. Series also include records related to New Age Products Limited.

Scope and content:

Series consists of records related to the career and activities of Gwen Mallard, including correspondence, newspaper clippings, and recipes. Topics include food and nutrition and Gwen's Vegetarian Diner.

Extent: ca. 20 cm of textual records

Scope and content: Series consists of records related to the two B.C. environmental associations founded by Derrick and Gwen Mallard: the Society for Promoting Environmental Conservation (S.P.E.C.), in Vancouver, 1968, and Citizens Association to Save the Environment (C.A.S.E.), in Victoria, 1972. Textual materials include administrative records, correspondence, financial records, meeting notes, newsletters and newsmagazines, pamphlets, reports, proposals, and applications.

Extent: ca. 5 cm of textual records

Scope and content: Series consists of records related to the community organizations that the Mallard's were involved with in the greater Victoria area, including the Association for the Protection of Rural Metchosin, the Saanich Peninsula Vision Committee, Save Saanich Peninsula Community Coalition, and the Sidney Environmental Advisory Committee.

7. Capital Regional District

Dates: 1990-2000

Extent: ca. 5 cm of textual records

Scope and content: Series consists of records related to Derrick Mallard's involvement with Capital Regional District (C.R.D.) committees and initiatives, including the Environment Committee, the Green Space Workshop, and the Roundtable on the Environment. Derrick Mallard was the chairman of the CRD Waste Management Advisory Group from 1988-1990.

Dates: 1994-2000

Extent: ca. 5 cm of textual records

Scope and content: Series consists of records related to two environmental foundations: Skies Above Foundation and the Earth Society Foundation. Derrick Mallard served as research director of Skies Above and the director of Earth Society, dates unknown. Series also contains materials related to Earth Day Victoria, 1993-1995.

Title: Issues

Dates: 1973-2000

Extent: ca. 1.8 m of textual records and graphic material

Scope and content: Series consists of records related to the Mallards' activities with the Citizens Association to Save the Environment (C.A.S.E.), on the following environmental topics and issues: agriculture, air quality, aquaculture, bovine growth hormone (BGH), biotechnology, butterflies, climate change, energy, food and nutrition, gypsy moth, Heals Gun Range (noise control), health freedom and natural medicine, nitinol, pesticide, plant breeder's rights, Saanich Inlet, sewage, Stockholm resolutions, sustainability and growth, transportation, war and resources, water, and west coast environmental law. Materials include correspondence, meeting minutes, reports, pamphlets and brochures, posters, newspaper clippings, handwritten notes, and photographs of events.

Slides depict people and places in B.C, including Tod Inlet, Thetis Lake, Spillimacheen, Buttle Lake, Azouetta Lake, Cathedral Grove (Alberni), Victoria, Beacon Hill Park (Victoria), Marble Canyon (Kootenay Park), Slocan Lake, Mill Bay, Columbia Valley, Kootenay Lake, Moberley Lake, Lake Louise, Clearwater River, Iron Mt. (Merritt), Okanagan Lake, Wabi Hill, Whatshan Mt.; C.A.S.E. educational slideshows; and slides arranged by topic, including butterflies, composting, the biosphere, and insects and the environment.
