#### **Biographical Sketch**

Kathleen Raine was born in London, England, and was a contemporary and friend of William Empson, J. Bronowski, Humphrey Jennings and other followers of I.A. Richards. During the 1940s, she began to write poetry. Her collections of poems include Stone and Flower and The Kingdom according to St. John. Her critical works include Blake and Tradition and Yeats the Initiate, the latter published by Dolmen Press in 1986.

# **Scope and Content**

The collection consists mainly of material generated in the process of publishing the book Yeats the Initiate (1986), consisting of typescripts, drafts, paste-ups, illustrations, and proofs; plus correspondence, mainly to Liam Miller at the Dolmen Press.

# RAINE, KATHLEEN Acc. 1990-010 1 Doc

The fonds consists of manuscript, typescript and photocopied files relevant to the publication by the Dolmen Press of <u>Yeats the Initiate</u> by Kathleen Raine. This book was a compilation of several previously published essays, along with new material, illustrated and footnoted, on various themes in the writings of W.B. Yeats.

Included are thirty letters to Kathleen Raine from the Dolmen Press publisher, Liam Miller. There are also letters from others involved in the compilation of the index, the illustrations, etc., as well as 55 items ranging from an alternate dust jacket to sets of proofs annotated and amended in holograph by both Kathleen Raine and Liam Miller. Much of the description is adapted from that of the manuscript vendor, Philobiblion.

Note: The order and grouping of the material received from the vendor, Philobiblion, is retained; this order appears to reflect the arrangement of K. Raine's working folders. The present arrangement designates "Files" placed in assigned "Folders" which contain one or more files.
