Biographical sketch

Mary Wallace Hamilton was born in New Westminster B.C. in 1891, attended School on Pender Island and subsequently Victoria High School. She graduated from McGill University in 1914 and taught 37 years (1914–51) at Victoria High School. In 1921–22 she took a year off, traveled around Europe and visited friends and relatives. She died in 1987.

Scope and content

Fonds consists of academic diplomas, personal letters written by Hamilton to her family during her trip to Europe from July, 1921 to July, 1922. The letters originate from England, France (Paris and Toulouse) and southern Italy and record many of Hamilton's observations and thoughts.
