Biographical sketch

The Centennial Commission was established circa 1963 to organize events celebrating the Canadian Centennial in 1967. The Commission disbanded circa 1968. The Centennial Voyageur Canoe Pageant, organized by Reg Fife, involved a canoe race from Rocky Mountain House, Alberta, to Montreal, Quebec, and took place from May to September, 1967. A trial race was held in 1966 from Lachine, Quebec, to New York City.

Scope and content

Fonds consists of records relating to the Centennial Voyageur Canoe Pageant, including subject files of organizer Reg Fife, notes relating to preparation and planning, publicity, weather reports, correspondence, speeches, personal data of participants, clippings and activity reports of the trial race, photographs of Alberta team, reproduction of painting of canoe trip on Lake Superior (ca. 1873), and clippings and activity reports of trial race, 1966, from Lachine, Quebec, to New York, N.Y.
