### **Biographical sketch**

Members of the Lee Hung family owned the firm Wing Tung Yuen, an import-export store, in Victoria, B.C. The store also served as a remittance centre for Victoria families to send money to their families via a remittance centre in Hong Kong or China.

### **Scope and content**

Fonds consists of Lee Hung's correspondence to his sons, Nai San, Nai Chu, and Nai Yin regarding family matters and their business, Wing Tung Yuen, in Victoria.

### **Notes**

Records were in the custody of J.P. Vinay, who obtained them from the Chinese Consolidated Benevolent Association.
