Biographical sketch

Barbara C. McKenzie was a warden in the Victoria Civilian Protection Area, 1941; a volunteer for Civil Defence Canada in 1945; took a course in anti-gas protection at the Gordon Head Camp, Victoria, in 1942; took several courses in first aid and home nursing from the Victoria Branch of the Canadian Red Cross Corps, 1942-45; and qualified as an instructor in Civil Defence rescue operations at Arnprior, Ontario, in 1955.

Scope and content

Fonds consists of correspondence, certificates, examination questions, course notes and readings, and civil defence pamphlets related to her training.
