**Biographical Sketch**

The Hollands are an eminent English family from Lancashire, one branch of which settled at Conway in North Wales, during the reign of Henry IV.

**Scope and Content**

The fonds consists of material about the genealogy of the Holland Family and some family memorabilia. It includes a book, printed 'for private circulation only' in 1899 (reprinted with additions, 1915) by Thomas Erskine Holland, called "The Hollands of Conway".
